EAST ZONE RECIPIENT GEORGIA GUTTADAURO

The East Zone scholarship winner is Georgia Guttadauro. Georgia is a graduate of Concord-Carlisle Regional High School in Carlisle, Massachusetts. She played first base on her varsity softball team, a position that earned her numerous awards, including the Dual County League All-Star Player of the Year Award. She was also named a Scholastic All-Star Award by the Boston Globe and the Boston Herald, as well as an All-Star title from the Lowell Sun. Georgia also played on the Black Ice National Tournament Team, the 2006 PONY Massachusetts State Champions and qualifiers for the 2007 PONY National Tournament, as well as the Concord Raiders Gold National Tournament Softball Team. Softball was not Georgia's only sport. She was also a starter on the varsity field hockey team, a position that earned her another Boston Globe All-Star title, and where she was recognized as a Dual County All-Star. Georgia will attend the University of Pennsylvania this fall.
